

## Using JigZone

### Join JigZone:

Go to <http://www.jigzone.com>



Click the **Sign In** link, then click "**New to JigZone**" to register using your "teacher name" (e.g. Mrs. Miller), WA email address and a password.

Click continue to access your "My JigZone" space.

### Prepare your photo using Picnik:

**Picnik** is a free web-based image editor.

Go to <http://www.picnik.com>

**NOTE:** It is recommended that you create a **Puzzles** folder in **My Documents** for saving your **JigZone** images.

Click **Upload** photo. Navigate to your saved photo. Select photo and click **Open**.

In the **Edit** tab, click **Resize**.



Change the BIGGER dimension of the photo to **400**. The other dimensions will automatically adjust. Click OK.

Click **Save & Share**.

- Name your file (this will become the name of your puzzle, so name it well).
- Leave the other settings as they are.
- Click **Save Photo**.
- Save the photo to your **Puzzles** folder.



## Create a Puzzle



Log into Jigzone (WA email and your password).

Under your "My JigZone" space, click "Add Photo."

Browse to the saved photo.

Select the photo and click **Open**, then click **Upload**.

After you have uploaded the picture, you will see all puzzles in the album.

- Click **Edit details** to change the puzzle name and description.
- Click **Open puzzle** to view/test the puzzle.
- Click **Embed/Link** to embed the puzzle into a webpage.
- Click **Send as postcard** to email to someone.

## Link a Puzzle on a webpage

- Click **Open Puzzle**
- The puzzle will open as a "20-piece classic."
- Copy and paste the URL into Edline, your wiki or any other webpage.

## Embed a Puzzle in your Wikispace (or other webpage)

- Click **Embed/Link**
- Select a **default puzzle cut**. First, select the default puzzle cut:
- Select desired **Embed** option (Typically, **Fixed size** or **Stretch to fit**).
- **Highlight** and **copy** the code from the **script** box.
- **Paste** the code into the **Embed Media** window on your Wikispaces page. (See **Wikispaces Cheat Sheet** for further instructions on embedding media).
